
Dear Prospective Youth Orchestra Students and Parents,

We are excited to announce that the Lake Michigan Youth Orchestra will be returning again this fall.

We are offering both video and in-person auditions. All students desiring to join a new group will need to audition in person or submit a video audition. The registration fee for the semester is \$105 and \$65 for additional students of the same family. A \$10 late fee will be charged after the October 10<sup>th</sup> rehearsal. The registration fee covers ALL aspects of the program and entitles each student to a free pass to all SMSO Mendel Mainstage concerts.

Throughout the term, participants will need to honor the COVID prevention requirements of the St. Joseph Public Schools and LMYO regarding masking and instrumental musician safety. Currently, all Covid precautions are optional.

A limited number of need-based scholarships for registration fees are available through the SMSO office. These scholarships require student assistance with LMYO organizational tasks 15 minutes before and after rehearsals.

## Audition Requirements for 2022-23 Season

Deadline: In-person on September 19 or virtual from Sept. 5-19. Auditions should include scale requirements and short a solo work of 3-6 minutes, no accompaniment needed. Please fill out <u>this Google form</u> or scan the QR code to submit a video link.

<u>YOUTH SYMPHONY STRING SCALES</u> (Students auditioning for Concert/Encore Strings should prepare 1-octave C,G or D major scales. Students auditioning for Youth Symphony should prepare at least 2-octaves of the scales listed below.)

## PERCUSSION
